HOME REPAIRS PROGRAM

What Can We Fix For You?

We install ramps for accessibility, grab rails, hand rails on stairs, insulation, interior storm windows, and smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, outside floodlights at entry ways, and replace rotten wood on exterior decks and stairs, defective light fixtures and faucets, and older electrical receptacles with ground fault interrupting (GFI) outlets.

Do You Know Who is Eligible for Repairs?

Eligibility is based on your gross annual household income and the number of people living in your home. For example, to be eligible for free materials and labor, your income must be less than \$40,600 for a household of one, or \$46,400 for two.

If your annual income is up to 25% more than this, you can buy the materials and have the work done free of charge by the Home Repairs Team.

Call Linda Strickland at the Town Office at (207) 833-5771, to apply. Senior(s) must be 60 or older, and the home must be owned by the senior or a family member.
